



THE BASICS (WHEN USING BLOCK SALT)

Typically, one block per person per month. Please note that your first month may see increased salt usage. This is because your softener is working hard to make plenty of brine

Having a softener means you may be using as little as a ¼ of the amount of products you were using before. Great for your body, your pocket and the environment.



It may take some getting used to though because even using less product you will get more suds. After bathing in soft water your skin should feel "silky". That is not the remnants of product, what you are feeling is your own smooth skin without left over soap scum or residue.

Did you know your dishwasher already contains a water softener? This is why we recommend the following...

DISHWASHER

- Set your dishwasher to the lowest possible hardness level
- Don't add dishwasher salt any more
- Use the minimum amount of good quality, low phosphate dishwasher detergent
- Reduce the amount of rinse aid by at least 50%
- Wash good china and crystal by hand



IN THE GARDEN

Don't waste the water from your softener in the garden!

Water your grass, shrubs and outside plants from an outside hard water tap. If this is fed by soft water just simply put your softener into by-pass *see page 11 of this guide for more info.

Do remember to turn your softener back on once you have finished using the outside tap.

ONGOING MAINTENANCE

Our quality softeners can last for many years, with you needing to do very little in the way of maintenance. Some customers report their softeners still going strong after 20 years!

You may experience salt creep or bridging from time to time, however, which is perfectly normal.

Like a reliable car, we do advise that you have your softener serviced annually



This is to check that it is working to its optimum performance, ensuring you receive beautiful soft water all the time.

Water Softening Servicing And Repairs

Once you have set up your service subscription, all that is left for you to do is to fill your softener with salt when required. This is all it takes to enjoy wonderful soft water.


Why Aftercare Is So Important

BY-PASSING YOUR SOFTENER

There may be times you need to by-pass your softener. For example, if you move house, if it's being serviced or if you have a soft feed to your outside tap and wish to use hard water.

Follow our easy step guide to put your softener into by-pass:

- 1. Set the by-pass valves to the OFF position and set the mains supply valve to the ON or OPEN position.
- 2. To restart the flow of soft water Set the by-pass valves to the ON or OPEN position and set the mains supply valve to the OFF position.
- 3. The softener can be put into bypass at any time. Water will still flow throughout the house, however, this water will be hard.



MANUAL REGENERATION



A manual regeneration may be necessary if your system runs out of salt or suffers a malfunction. How to do this will vary from brand to brand.

ADDING A DRINKING SYSTEM

- You've made the right decision for a limescale-free house, now <u>spare a thought for the water you put into your body!</u>
- A water softener only removes limescale, but the water you drink may also contain many impurities such as lead, chlorine, pesticides and pharmaceuticals.
- Our extensive range of drinking water filtration systems will ensure you are able to find the right solution for you and your family. Please note that on some water filtration models you benefit from an extended warranty if you also have a water softener (as it stops the system getting clogged up with limescale).

WARRANTY WORK

Please note that on warranty work, you only pay labour charges on items that are not an integral part of the water softener e.g. pipe work etc. Otherwise, you do pay for labour on all water softener parts that are over 1 year old. A call out charge is £120 per hour inclusive of VAT + Parts (if no longer under warranty).

FAQ'S



My system seems to be regenerating more frequently. Is this normal?

Remember, your system is demand operated, adjusting automatically to your water usage. If you do not think that your water usage has increased due to extra house guests, additional laundry or some other reason, check for any leaky plumbing, dripping taps or running toilets, all of which can contribute to more frequent regenerations.



How will I know when it is time to add salt?

Lift the lid of the cabinet to check the level of salt. If you can see water, it is time to add salt. You can add salt anytime there is enough room to accommodate additional blocks or tablets.



My water doesn't seem soft. How can I be sure that my system is regenerating properly?

Ensure the water supply to the softener is not by-passed, that the by-pass valve (grey handle) is not open and there is salt in the cabinet. Please call if you are still unsure.



My water softener is making a noise, is this normal?

If you are using a non-electric (block salt) softener during the regeneration process, you may hear the sound of water filling up during the daytime period, which can last up to 20 minutes. For electric (tablet salt) softener any noise from the regeneration process will be timed to happen during the night (typically midnight to 2am) which can persist for between 1-2 hours.



There is water gushing out into the outside drain, why is this? This is quite parmed. It is water being flushed away as part of the

This is quite normal. It is water being flushed away as part of the regeneration process and may last for up to 2 hours.
